**ABSTRACT** The MERIDIONAL, AIRE, and FLOW EU-funded projects will present recent advancements in wind energy research, covering onshore, offshore, and airborne technologies. The webinar will showcase the collaborative tool WindLab, a knowledge and data hub. WindLab was developed by the three projects with the aim of enhancing knowledge transfer and providing access to publicly available research data. The session will explore the rationale behind the collaboration, a quick peak into the tool itself, its features, highlighting the role of each project in the development of this platform. Key partners, including project coordinators and task leaders, will discuss the contributions of the projects to WindLab, offering a comprehensive overview of the current state of wind energy research and data-sharing practices.
